

## Recycling Collection Materials Guide

<b>Cardboard</b>  flatten boxes; remove large staples & plastic wrap; tape & labels are OK; must be clean; DO NOT bundle or tie together	<b>Paperboard</b>  flatten; no plastic-coated paperboard that held liquid (e.g. milk cartons)	<b>Newspaper &amp; Phonebooks</b>  remove plastic strapping, rubber bands & plastic bags	<b>Magazines &amp; Catalogs</b>  remove from plastic bags	<b>Mail &amp; Office Paper</b>  put shredded paper in clear plastic bag; staples are OK; plastic windows in envelopes are OK
<b>Plastic Bottles Jugs &amp; Tubs</b>  must be stamped 1-7; NO STYROFOAM; wash clean; labels are OK; throw away caps & lids	<b>Plastic Shopping Bags</b>  must be empty, clean & dry; must be stamped ♻️ or ♻️	Acceptable Items for recycling. Please rinse and place clean recyclable items in your container for processing.  Keeping trash and non-accepted items out of the cart helps keep the cost of recycling affordable.		
<b>Metal Cans &amp; Fall</b>  wash clean; labels are OK; aerosol cans must be empty - throw away cap & nozzle	<b>Glass Bottles &amp; Jars</b>  clear & colored food or beverage glass; wash clean; remove lids & recyls (if metal); labels are OK			

**Do Not Put These Items in the Recycling Bin**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>large plastics and plastics without recycle symbol: pool covers, tarps, pool toys, zip-top bags, cling wrap</li> <li>electronics</li> <li>plastic caps &amp; lids</li> <li>Styrofoam plates, cups, take-out boxes, egg cartons, packing material</li> <li>needles &amp; medical waste</li> <li>batteries</li> <li>scrap metal</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>tools, screws &amp; hardware</li> <li>propane &amp; helium tanks</li> <li>paint cans</li> <li>pots, pans &amp; silverware</li> <li>string lights, chains, ropes</li> <li>dishes, paper plates &amp; napkins</li> <li>windows, doors &amp; mirrors, ceramics</li> <li>paper cartons &amp; juice boxes</li> <li>label &amp; sticker paper; photographs</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>plastic-coated or waxy paper</li> <li>spiral-bound notebooks</li> <li>books</li> <li>pet food bags</li> <li>galle, ribbons or bows</li> <li>wrapping paper &amp; tissue paper</li> <li>greasy or dirty paper</li> <li>hazardous substance containers (antifreeze, motor oil, etc.)</li> </ul>
