



City of Scottville - Riverside Park Rules

(Approved By City Commission 07/28/2025)

- Campers must register with camp management before setting up any Park campsite.
- Check-in time is 2:00 PM and check-out time is 11 AM.
- Only one (1) recreational vehicle (RV) and one (1) tent may be set-up on any Riverside Park site and no more than eight (8) people may occupy any campsite as campers.
- Up to two (2) motor vehicles are authorized to be parked on any campsite rented by the campers or visitors of that campsite. Additional parking for additional vehicles of campers or visitors is available but is in a non-adjacent area subject to availability.
- UTVs, golf carts, and any motorized motor vehicle or vehicle must be driven by a licensed driver and must drive only on the roadway or be parked at the owner's/operator's campsite. Every UTV or golf cart must have a ORV sticker/license from the State of Michigan or another governmental authority.
- Quiet hours are from 10:00 P.M. to 8 A.M. All non-registered guests or visitors must leave Riverside Park by 10:00 P.M. All children who are not accompanied by an adult must not leave their campsite after 10:00 P.M.
- The cutting of wood, limbs, or shrubs inside Riverside Park is prohibited. No camper or visitor is authorized to bring firewood into Riverside Park for any purpose. Firewood for use inside Riverside Park can only be obtained from the Riverside Park store.
- The use of the Riverside Park swimming pool and showers without payment of a fee is only permitted for registered campers and family members who accompany them. Otherwise, only residents of the City of Scottville and guests of campers may use the swimming pool for a fee of \$3.00/person/day. For the safety of everyone, no swimming or other use of the Riverside Park swimming pool is permitted at other than the posted the posted hours of use. No food, drinks, glass objects or containers, rough housing, running, or diving is permitted inside or around the swimming pool area. Children in diapers cannot enter the Riverside Park swimming pool unless they wear disposable and water-approved diapers. All children who swim or otherwise use the Riverside Park Pool must be under the direct supervision of a parent, guardian, or adult always.
- No firearms, bows or arrows, fireworks, or any other weapons are permitted inside of Riverside Park.
- Dumping of wastewater is prohibited.
- Selling and/or solicitation of the sale of any item is strictly prohibited inside Riverside Park.
- All pets must always be on a leash/lead and the leash/lead shall be no longer than six (6) feet. Dogs that exhibit aggressive behavior in the sole opinion of the Park personnel may be required to be removed by their owners or stewards. Other than verifiable service animals, no pets of any type are permitted in the pool or pool area of Riverside Park or the Riverside Park convenience store.
- In case of severe weather, all campers and visitors should seek shelter inside the restrooms at the back of Riverside Park.

Caveat: Riverside Park is owned and operated by the City of Scottville. All City rules that are not mentioned and all City Ordinances apply within Riverside Park. The Park Managers and Park Rangers have the authority to enforce any Riverside Park rule. Disruptive behavior and/or any disregard of any of these rules may result in a guest's eviction from Riverside Park without renumeration of any fees already paid. Failure to follow the directions from a Park Manager or a Park Ranger can result in enforcement actions that include citations, fines, and/or other legal actions and sanctions.
